# Ruling alliance raises Disha Salian issue in Maharashtra council, UBT leaders see red

## Attempts may lead to malign my image: Aditya Thackeray

**MUMBAI, MARCH 20** / - The Maharashtra Legislative Council on Thursday saw heated exchanges as ruling alliance members raised the Disha Salian death controversy in the House to which Shiv Sena (UBT) leaders took a strong exception, leading to an adjournment.

Manisha Kavyade (Shiv Sena) and Pravin Darekar (BJP) raised the issue through a point of information, a day after Satish Salian, father of Disha, former manager of actor Sushant Singh Rajput, said he had moved the Bombay High Court seeking a fresh probe into the circumstances under which she was found dead in June 2020. The petition demanded registration of a First Information Report against Shiv Sena (UBT) leader and MLA Aditya Thackeray. The leader of Opposition in the Upper House Ambadas Danve, who belongs to the Sena (UBT), objected to the raising of the issue in the House. "It is a politically

motivated case. The government can conduct inquiries and even set up another SIT but same rules should apply to the suspicious death of Pooja Chavan, 'hessid, referring to the death of a young woman in Pune in 2011 that led to the Maha Vikas Aghadi minister Sanjay Rathod's resignation. Rathod is a minister in the current BJP-led dispensation too.

Danve further alleged that the Council was being used to settle political scores. "Even a gram panchayat operates in a more organised manner," he remarked. Anil Parab, another Shiv Sena (UBT) leader, said a case against Thackeray was going on for more than year and a half.

"The final hearing was scheduled for February 17, but it was postponed. The fresh petition filed by Disha's father is a copy-paste petition. The matter is subjective, how can it even be discussed? The CBI has given a clean chit," he said.

Parab also read out Kayande's past tweet supporting Aditya Thackeray, posted when she was with the United Thackeray Sena (UBT). "Kayande supported Thackeray and later changed colours like a chameleon," he said. Parab also asked why the ruling alliance did not seek the resignation of UBT MLA and minister Jaykumar Gore.

The UBT leader was apparently referring to allegations by a woman that Gore had sent her objectionable photographs. The minister earlier this month had denied the allegation and said he was already acquitted by the court. Minister Dada Bhuse objected to Parab's remarks, accusing him of using inappropriate language against a woman legislator (Kayande). "Such language

cannot be used in the House," Bhuse said. The resultant uproar led to an adjournment with both sides remarking that the exchange was sharp.

Meanwhile, Thackeray on Thursday said attempts were being made to malign his image through the accidental death case of Disha Salian, and he will present his side before the court. "Attempts are being made for the last five years to malign my image. We will put forth our side in the court. We will give our replies (to the allegations) in the court," Thackeray, a former Maharashtra minister, told reporters here. Disha Salian died on June 8, 2020, after falling off the 14th floor of a residential building in suburban Malad. The city police had then

registered an Accidental Death Report (ADR) case. Six days later, Bollywood star Kajol's allegedly committed suicide in a flat in Bandra. Targeting Aditya Thackeray on Thursday, BJP minister Nitesh Rane said as per the Supreme Court's past decisions, if a politician is facing allegations of rape, he must be arrested.

He also demanded Thackeray's resignation as an MLA. "We have demanded his resignation in the House assembly," Rane told reporters. Shiv Sena (UBT) leader Ambadas Danve, who is the Leader of Opposition in the Legislative Council, alleged that the BJP was behind the attempts to target Thackeray.

The BJP-led government was free to investigate the case, he told reporters. NCP (SP) leader Anil Deshpande questioned why Disha Salian's father remained silent for five years, and said it was pure politics. (PTI)

# Uttarakhand: Case lodged against former minister's son for illegal road construction

**RISHIKESH, MARCH 20** / - Former Uttarakhand cabinet minister and Rishikesh MLA Prem Chand Agarwal sparked controversy again after his son was booked for allegedly constructing road on government land without obtaining permission from the authorities, an official said Thursday. Agarwal, who held key portfolios such as Finance and Parliamentary Affairs in Chief Minister Pushkar Singh Dhami's cabinet, had resigned recently after his remarks against the hill people in the state Assembly sparked a major controversy.

According to district magistrate Parul Garwal Ashish Chauthan, a case has been registered against Piyush Agarwal under relevant sections of the Public Property Act in the name of Youth Services SDM Chauthan.

An approach road was built to connect Piyush Agarwal's proposed hotel to the main road. An investigation carried out by CS Punjab Revenue Inspector 1.5-metre deep wider and illegally constructed on the

government land from the main road downward about the permission of authorities Chauthan said. The government land in question is located in the village of Khairkhali Gram under Maral Gram Panchayat, Patti Uday Pur

Talla of the Laxman Julua area, with Kharsa number about the permission of authorities Chauthan said in his report, adding that it is recorded in government records as a bush. The investigation report was sent by Pundir to SDM Yamkeshwar. (PTI)
